

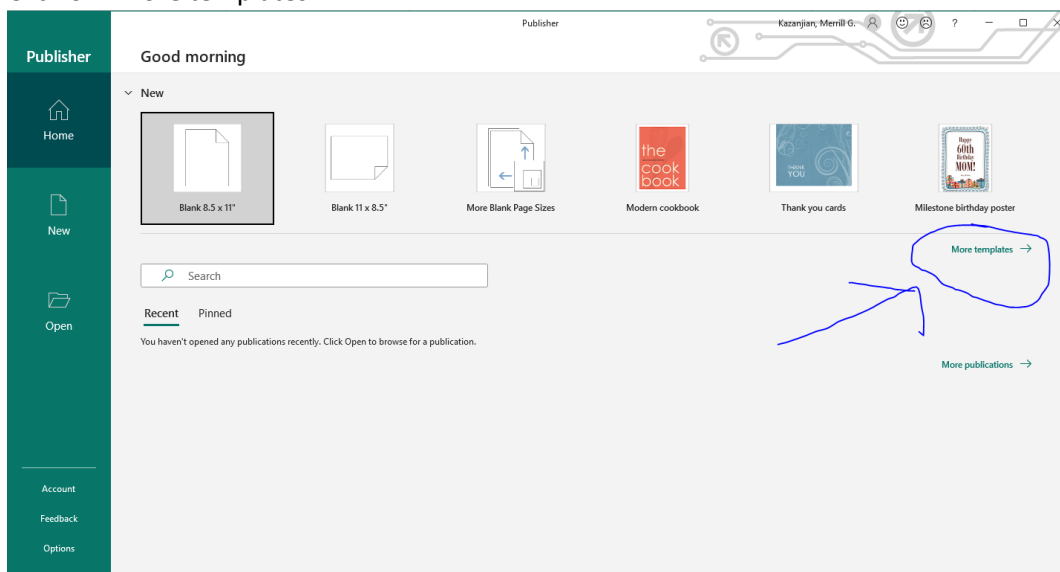

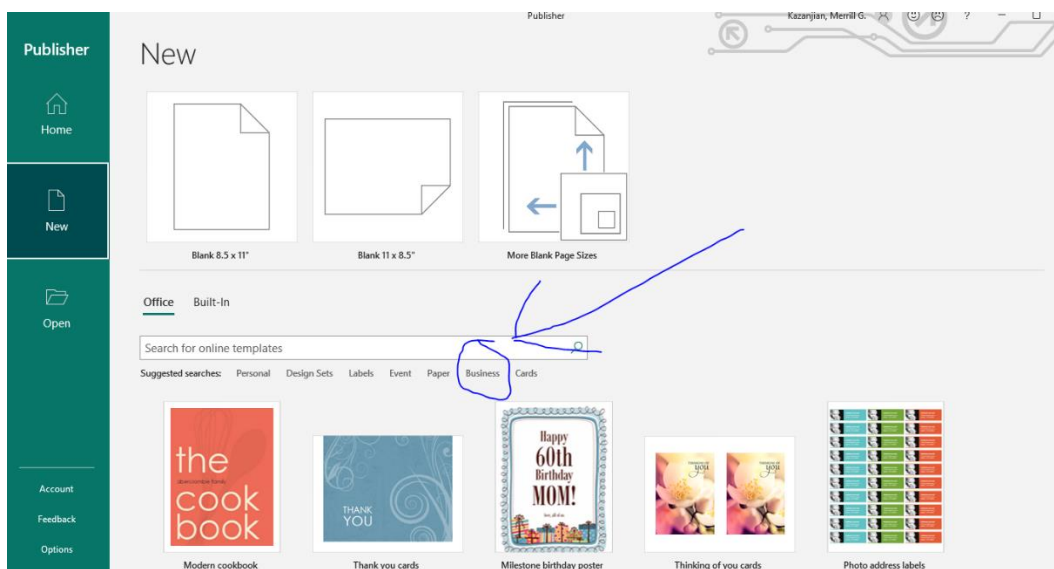
Creating a (Food) Menu on Microsoft Publisher Part 1

Today, you are going to experiment with the second of two existing templates on Microsoft Publisher. You will combine part 1 and part 2 to form an attractive menu for a restaurant that has hired you to design a menu. Below are your step-by-step instructions.

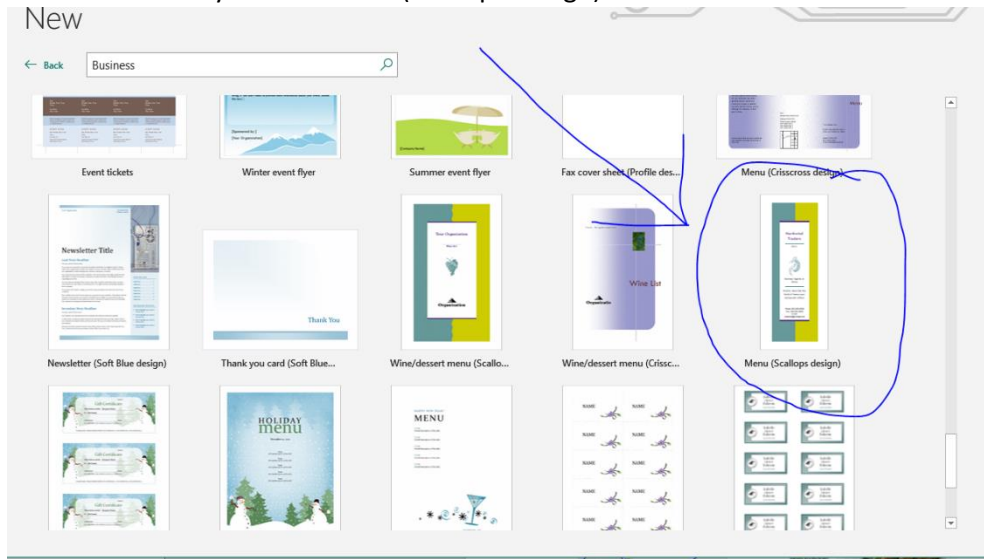
- 1.) Go to Start Menu and open Microsoft Publisher
- 2.) Click on “more templates”



- 3.) Click on “business”



4.) Scroll down until you see “Menu (Scallops Design)”



5.) Look at the color scheme of your first design. What colors are dominant? The “Menu (Scallops Design)” has a default of blue and green. Change the colors by double clicking on the color background (image A below) and then going to “recolor” (image 2 below) which pops up when you double click.

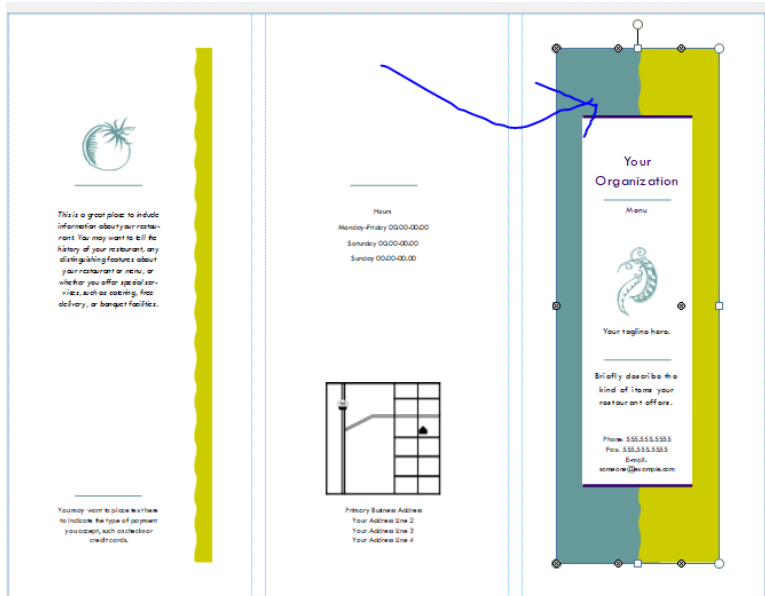

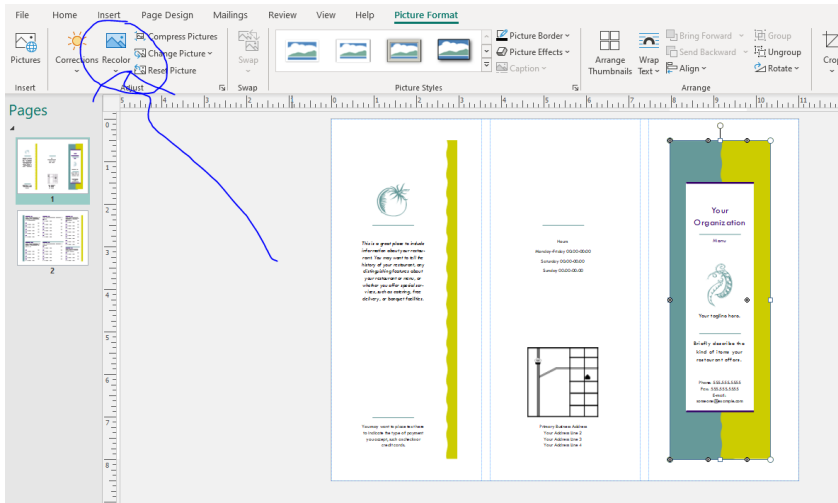
