IDEA #1

IDEA #2

<b>Possible Solutions/Projects</b>	Our class can fix this problem by making <u>signs and posters</u> or doing <u>weekly meetings with the school, principle about the issue</u>
<b>Benefits</b>	This solution or project will be good for our school because <u>it will better the food in the school so that the students can be able to enjoy their meals.</u>
