IDEA #1

Challenges	This solution or project will be hard to do because <u>there are many places that need fixing around the entire school so this project could take a while. As well as find a new classroom for the kids that need their classrooms fixed, and we are on a budget so it's also expensive.</u>

IDEA #2
