IDEA #2	
<b>Problem/Issue to Address</b>	A problem at my school is <u>exploring college programs</u> . This is a problem for <u>(students)</u> / teachers / community members) because <u>experience is necessary</u> .
<b>Possible Solutions/Projects</b>	Our class can fix this problem by making <u>arrangements for tours</u> or doing <u>handouts to motivate young people</u> .
<b>Benefits</b>	This solution or project will be good for our school because <u>it will bring up college attendee number</u> .
